

HOW TO SUBMIT A BYLAW CHANGE PROPOSAL

This is a bylaw year and we encourage each of you to submit any changes that you would like to see brought to the floor of the National Convention. This is a brief explanation of doing just that. Upon request of members I have simplified this process so that everyone feels comfortable.

The Bylaw Proposal must be postmarked or emailed in triplicate to headquarters at least 90 days prior to the start of the national convention. This year that would fall on May 15, 2017.

Make sure the date is the top.
